In-year Admissions

Nursery Class Applications

Applicationeccivedeany time after the child's second birthday. Places will be allocated using the academy's admission criteria by order of priority. Additional forms of identity may also b required to establish eligibility.

Important notes to parents

Evidence of identity

If the parent is required to provide supplemental evidence to support the application (e.g. council tax bill), this e should be provided at the time of application. If not provided, evidence may be sought by the academy followin closing date for applications. This information must have been correct at the date of closing for applications.

False Evidence

Incomplete applications

If there is an incomplete application for a child, in circumstances where parents cannot agree on a preferred sc the main address where the resides, the Trust Board will suspemptication untilepate agree. This will mean that if the closing date has passed, the child will not be considered in the admission round and if all place been allocated then the child will not be given a place and the application may be treated as a late application.
